

The Minnesota Medical Association is aligned with 33 local component medical societies in the state. Each component medical society offers local resources and services for physicians living and working in their jurisdiction. Membership in the MMA is concurrent with membership in a local component medical society.

Component medical society membership can be based upon office or home address. Physicians who work in one component medical society and live in another can choose either as their component medical society. Physicians who move across component society borders should contact the MMA Membership Department to inquire about transferring their membership to their new component medical society.

For the purposes of representation on the MMA Board of Trustees, component medical societies are grouped together into trustee districts. Members from each trustee district elect trustees to the Board.
