MINNETONKA PHYSICIAN TO RECEIVE MMA COMMUNITY SERVICE AWARD

MINNEAPOLIS – J. Kevin Croston, M.D., who practices in Fridley and Robbinsdale, will receive the Minnesota Medical Association's Community Service Award at its 153rd Annual Meeting. The award honors MMA physicians with an outstanding record of community service.

Croston practices with Specialists in General Surgery in Fridley and has campaigned vigorously for a statewide trauma network that was recently approved by the Minnesota Legislature. This network will improve trauma care and increase the survival rate of trauma victims in both urban and rural Minnesota. Croston is also the surgical director of trauma at North Memorial Medical Center in Robbinsdale, and leads many other trauma prevention efforts in his community.

The award will be presented at the MMA Awards Luncheon on September 14. The Minnesota Medical Association is a professional association of about 10,000 physicians, medical students, residents, and fellows.
