MINNEAPOLIS PHYSICIAN TO RECEIVE MMA COMMUNITY SERVICE AWARD

MINNEAPOLIS – Douglas Pryce, M.D., will receive the Minnesota Medical Association's Community Service Award at its 153rd Annual Meeting. The award honors MMA physicians with an outstanding record of community service.

Pryce, who specializes in internal medicine, began working with the Somali community shortly after coming to the Hennepin County Medical Center in 1995. He has studied the effects of geographic dislocation on the health of the Somali population and enlisted the support of members of the community. Pryce was the chair of a fundraiser to benefit immigrant health care and serves on the Board of Directors of the Somali Health Project.

The award will be presented at the MMA Awards Luncheon on September 14. The Minnesota Medical Association is a professional association of about 10,000 physicians, medical students, residents, and fellows.
