DULUTH PHYSICIAN REELECTED AMA ALTERNATE DELEGATE

MINNEAPOLIS – The Minnesota Medical Association has reelected Gail E. Baldwin, M.D., of Duluth to serve a two-year term as alternate delegate to the American Medical Association House of Delegates.

The MMA is a professional organization representing about 10,000 physicians, fellows, residents, and medical students in Minnesota. The election was held September 21 in Mankato during the MMA's 154th Annual Meeting.

Gail E. Baldwin, M.D., is a board certified family physician who has been practicing in Duluth, Minnesota and Superior, Wisconsin since 1992. For the last seven years she has served as the medical director of the Lake Superior Community Health Center in Duluth and Superior. She is a member of the associate staff of the University of Minnesota School of Medicine in Duluth.

She is currently serving as an alternate delegate to the AMA. She has served as secretary/treasurer, vice president, president-elect, and president of the Lake Superior Medical Society.
