MINNETONKA PHYSICIAN REELECTED AMA ALTERNATE DELEGATE

MINNEAPOLIS – The Minnesota Medical Association has reelected David L. Estrin, M.D., of Minnetonka to serve a two-year term as alternate delegate to the American Medical Association House of Delegates.

The MMA is a professional organization representing about 10,000 physicians, fellows, residents, and medical students in Minnesota. The election was held September 21 in Mankato during the MMA's 154th Annual Meeting.

David L. Estrin, M.D., practices at South Lake Pediatrics in Minnetonka and is an adjunct associate professor at the University of Minnesota.

Estrin has served as secretary of the MMA and on the Board of Trustees. In 2003 he was elected alternate delegate to the AMA.

AMA alternate delegates attend meetings of the AMA House of Delegates, participate in the development of AMA policies on health care issues, and at the state level, take part in policy development through the work of the MMA Board of Trustees.
