MANKATO PHYSICIAN REELECTED AMA ALTERNATE DELEGATE

MINNEAPOLIS – The Minnesota Medical Association has reelected Paul C. Matson, M.D., of the Mankato area to serve a two-year term as alternate delegate to the American Medical Association House of Delegates.

The MMA is a professional organization representing about 10,000 physicians, fellows, residents, and medical students in Minnesota. The election was held September 21 in Mankato during the MMA's 154th Annual Meeting.

Paul C. Matson, M.D., is an orthopaedic surgeon who has been practicing at the Orthopaedic and Fracture Clinic in Mankato since 1988. He is also a clinical associate professor at the University of Minnesota. He has served as a medical volunteer in Kenya and Cameroon.

He is currently an alternate delegate to the AMA House of Delegates. He has also served the MMA as chair of the Board of Trustees and president. He has been a member of the MMA House of Delegates since 1989.
