ROCHESTER PHYSICIAN REELECTED AMA DELEGATE

MINNEAPOLIS—The Minnesota Medical Association has reelected Sally J. Trippel, M.D., M.P.H., of Rochester to serve a two-year term as delegate to the American Medical Association House of Delegates.

The MMA is a professional organization representing about 10,000 physicians, fellows, residents, and medical students in Minnesota. The election was held September 21 in Mankato during the MMA's 154th Annual Meeting.

Dr. Trippel has been a staff consultant in the Mayo Clinic Department of Internal Medicine, Division of Preventive, Occupational and Aerospace Medicine, since 1986. She is board certified in internal medicine, as well as in public health and general preventive medicine.

In addition to her internal medicine practice, Dr. Trippel staffs a refugee clinic at the Olmsted County Health Department.

AMA delegates attend meetings of the AMA House of Delegates, participate in the development of AMA policies on health care issues, and at the state level, take part in policy development through the work of the MMA Board of Trustees.
